

OMAMORI and OJUZU INFORMATION

The Northern California Koyasan Temple is offering the purchase of omamori and ojuzu for the 2022 year. Omamori are amulets and ojuzu are prayer beads. Enclosed in the omamori is paper or a piece of wood with prayers written on them to bring good luck or good fortune to its bearer or for protection to ward off bad luck or misfortune. All omamori and ojuzu are blessed during the Goma Fire Ritual at the January 1, 2022, New Year's Shusho-e Service.

Download and complete the omamori and/or ojuzu order form(s) and submit with your donation check to NC Koyasan Temple / Omamori, 1400 U Street, Sacramento, CA 95818 by Wednesday, January 12, 2022.

Return all old omamori to the Temple for proper disposal by burning in the fire ritual as a sign of respect to the deity that gave assistance to the bearer of the omamori throughout the year.

For members residing in the Sacramento County area, the omamori and ojuzu orders will be available only for pick up. Members who reside outside Sacramento County (ex. Bay Area) will receive their order by postal mail.

Orders can be picked up at the Temple's Social Hall on the following scheduled dates and time.

- January 22, 2022 10:00 am to 1:00 pm
- January 23, 2022 10:00 am to 1:00 pm

If you are not able to pick up your order on the above scheduled dates, please contact the Temple to arrange a date and time.

If you missed placing your order by the January 12, 2022, deadline, you may still purchase the omamori and/or ojuzu anytime during the year by calling the Temple at (916) 444-0111 or by email at info@nckoyasan.org.
