

OMAMORI and OJUZU INSTRUCTIONS

The Northern California Koyasan Temple is offering the purchase of omamori and ojuzu for the 2023 year. An omamori is an amulet and ojuzu are prayer beads. Enclosed in the omamori is paper or a piece of wood with prayers written to bring good luck or good fortune to its bearer or for protection to ward off bad luck or misfortune. All omamori and ojuzu are blessed during the Goma Fire Ritual at the New Year's Day Shusho-e Service.

Omamori and ojuzu are available for purchase anytime during the year. If you reside in the Sacramento County area, the omamori and ojuzu orders will only be available for pick up. If you reside outside Sacramento County (ex. Bay area), you will receive your order by mail.
